



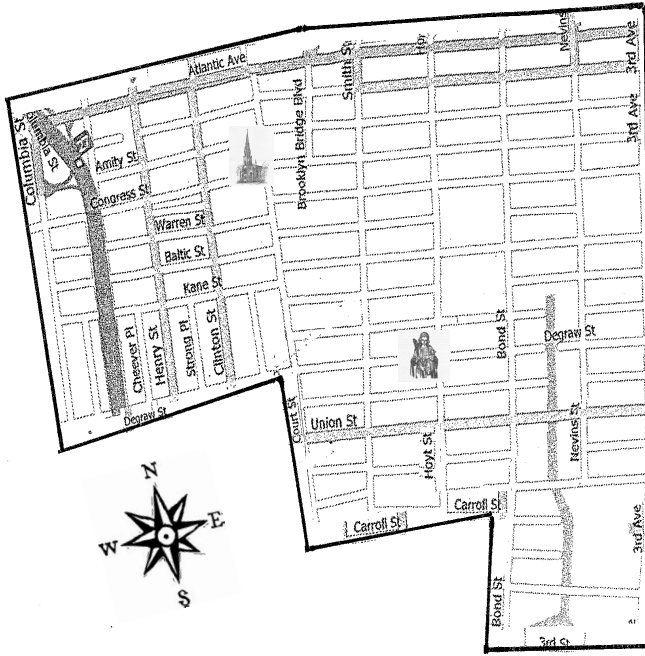

SPSA Celebration of
70th Anniv. Jubilee
of **Sister Innocentia** Lipari, MSBT
on the Vigil of Pentecost at St. Paul's,
Sat., June 11, 2011 at the 5 PM Mass.

All parishioners are encouraged to come on the Vigil of Pentecost to this Mass of Thanksgiving for Sister's 70 years of commitment to religious life and devoted parochial service. 50 of those 70 years she has spent in our neighborhood in the parishes of St. Peter-Our Lady of Pilar (1961-1975) St. Peter's-St. Paul's-Our Lady of Pilar (1975-2007); and St. Paul & St. Agnes (2007 to the present).

Sister Innocentia was born in her family's home at 36 1st Place in Red Hook (now Carroll Gardens) and grew up in St. Stephen's Parish (now Sacred Hearts-St. Stephen). She entered the Missionary Sisters of the Most Blessed Trinity in 1941. After her novitiate, from 1942 to 1961, Sister worked in parishes in West Orange, NJ; Cambridge, MA; Ensley, AL; and Patterson, NJ.

After the Mass of Thanksgiving on June 11th, every parishioner will have the opportunity to greet Sister personally at a reception in St. Paul's Hall.

As in past years, SPSA invites all graduates of the parish -- from preschool through postdoctoral --to participate in a baccalaureate Mass of their choice on **Sat., June 25** or **Sun., June 26**.
